HOW TO CHOOSE A LIGATURE



SENSATION AND PERCEPTION...

- . Play with your own ligature first.
- Under the same conditions, test the new ligature for its smoothness in transition between registers, consistent volume and its sound quality in the lower, middle and upper ranges. At the same time, listen for the subtle differences apparent when playing piano and forte.
- Test how easily you can play staccato.
- If possible, test it with someone else present. It's easier for another musician other than the player themselves to hear the differences between various ligatures.

ADVICE FOR CHOOSING THE RIGHT LIGATURE

- Try the various ligature models. Different types of ligatures meet different requirements.
- The higher density of gold enhances the resonance transferred by reed to the mouthpiece / instrument.
- Metal ligatures, alternatively, are used for: Large concert halls, soloist work.
- Special fabric ligatures are preferable for : Small halls / rooms, chamber music, playing in groups
